
There are two ways to gain full access. Choose one of the following to log-in.

I. Log-in through LearnAlberta

1. Go to <http://www.learnalberta.ca>
2. Click on the Online Reference Centre tab. Scroll down and click on the TeachingBooks.net link.

II. Log-in directly to Teaching Books

1. Go to <http://www.teachingbooks.net>
2. Click on the SignIn button at the top right.
3. At the next screen, enter your Westwind email address. Click Submit.
