Orange Shirt Day

Orange Shirt Day recognizes and honours the experiences of survivors of residential schools and shows a collective commitment to ensure that Every Child Matters. It is an opportunity to come together in the spirit of reconciliation and hope for generations of children to come. The Board is encouraging all Westwind students and staff to wear an orange shirt to school on September 30 to show their commitment to the principle that every child matters.

Minister of Education Visits Westwind School Division

The Board of Trustees discussed the grand opening celebration of Stirling School, which will be held on Tuesday, September 17, 2019, at 6:00pm. Minister of Education Adriana LaGrange and Minister of Infrastructure Prasad Panda, along with several other local dignitaries, will be joining Westwind in this celebration. The Board also has a scheduled meeting with the Minister on September 19, and during the board meeting they narrowed down a list of several priorities they would like to discuss with the Minister LaGrange during her visit.

Westwind Teachers

The Board discussed plans to recognize World Teacher Day (October 5) by visiting schools on October 3, 2019. A motion was also passed by the Board to ratify the **Memorandum of Agreement** between Westwind School Division and the Alberta Teachers' Association dated June 27, 2019.





Assistant Superintendent Austin Nunn gave a presentation to the Board about Hope Squad, school-based programs made up of students who are trained to watch for at-risk students—provide friendship, identify warning signs, and seek help from adults. The goal of Hope Squad is to seek to reduce self-destructive behaviour and youth suicide by training, building, and creating change in schools and communities.
