TECH DEPARTMENT UPDATE

Mr. Lyle Roberts, Director of Technology, shared information with the Board related to the start up of the 2020/2021 school year. Westwind is currently using several machines that are five years old and older that are not supported by Apple or Google. As well, Chromebooks that are five years old are not supported and cannot be updated. Tech is currently developing a plan to replace as much technology as possible. Since Mr. Roberts has joined Westwind, most work has been to redesign the network to make it more secure and as flexible as possible. Tech is updating copiers, so the staff all have a PIN code to print to and make copies. The tech team is also currently installing a new sound system at CJHS. Board Chair, Mr. Ralph asked Mr. Roberts to pass along thanks to the tech department from the Board for their hard work.

WWSD CO/EXTRA CURRICULAR

On Wednesday, October 7, CTV News Lethbridge interviewed Superintendent Mr. Darren Mazutinec, Cardston High School Principal Mr. Ken McMurray, Division Psychologist and volleyball coach Mr. Conrad Boehme, as well as several students on the partial return to athletics Westwind has adopted. Mr. Mazutinec expressed the desire to reinstate other co-curricular and extra curricular activities as soon as possible, all while staying within the guidelines that Alberta Health Services has established. He went on to note and thank Westwind staff, including teachers, and support staff for volunteering hundreds of hours in support of student activities.
