School Council Meetings

For any school year, the first meeting of the school council must be held within 40 days after the start of the school year or as specified in the bylaws of the school council (School Councils Regulation). As per AP110, at the first meeting, each Principal shall ensure that the incoming School Council executive has a current updated version of the Alberta School Council Resource Manual and shall review annually with the School Council:

- Alberta School Council Resource Manual;
- Administrative Procedure 110 School Councils;
- School policies (local);
- School Council bylaws (local);
- The school's combined Three-Year Education Plan/Annual Education Results Report (AERR).

Upcoming Division School Council Meeting

Alberta School Council Engagement Grant

Alberta Education now provides approximately \$1 million directly to school councils through the Alberta School Council Engagement (ASCE) Grant to enhance collaboration between parents and schools on education priorities. This grant gives each school council in the province \$500 per year under the new direct funding approach.

The Government of Canada has proclaimed Sept. 30 as the <u>National Day</u> <u>for Truth and Reconciliation</u>. The intention of the day is to recognize and honour residential school survivors, their families and communities. It will also ensure that public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and legacy of residential schools remains a vital component of the reconciliation process.

For the 2022-23 school year, there will be no school on Friday, Sept. 30 to commemorate truth and reconciliation across the Division.

The Division asks that all schools recognize <u>Truth and Reconciliation</u> <u>Week</u> from Sept. 27 to Oct. 1, 2021. This week will also continue the conversations of <u>Every Child Matters</u> and <u>Orange Shirt Day</u> with students while learning about the history and legacy of residential schools.
