

**During registration, you will need to provide documents confirming:**

- the address for the student's parent/guardian
- legal proof of the student's name, citizenship status and birthdate

**Legal documentation is required for the following:**

- Parent Custody Agreement, if there are restrictions on access
- Guardianship Letter if parents live in Alberta. NOTE: If parents live outside Alberta, legal guardianship must be applied for through the Alberta government.
